## Teen's Wish to be an Italian Chef Granted by Chefs at MAC 24/7 at Hilton Waikiki

June 24, 2016 - (Honolulu, Hawaii) — Wish kid Adrian has battled leukemia for years, and uses his culinary skills to take his heart and soul to a land far, far away from the daily struggle of childhood illness. On Wednesday, June 22, his taste buds were in Italy as he created fettuccine with award-winning Chef James Aptakin, executive chef of M.A.C. 24/7 at the Hilton Waikiki Beach on Kuhio, and sous chef Edmund Kwok.

California natives, wish teen Adrian and his family had planned to be in Sicily this week—for an Italian culinary experience that had been in the works for over a year—until a European airline strike left them grounded. Within the hour, Adrian's wish coordinator contacted the Make-A-Wish Hawaii chapter and rerouted Adrian and his family to Hawaii, where the local chapter went to work, creating a gastronomical experience that would give wish teen Adrian the magical experience his heart so desired.

When Chef James Aptakin heard of wish teen Adrian's change of plans, he set the stage—and the table—for an authentic Italian culinary experience, complete with an eclectic menu of Italian salad, handmade fettucine, various flavorful sauces and a spaghetti gelato for dessert, provided by IL Gelato.

"At the end of this experience," said Chef James, "all Adrian is going to know about Hawaii is 'Aloha,' how to shaka, and the magic of Hawaii's hospitality. Everything else from beginning to end is going to be authentic Italy."

Friends of Chef James donated gifts to surprise wish-teen-turned-chef Adrian including a hand-embroidered chef jacket by Malihini Hawaii uniforms, a handmade Koa wood cutting board from Foundwood, a recipe book with all the recipes learned during the cooking experience, and a framed, signed certificate of achievement for graduating a master chef class in Italian pasta-making.

The cooking class astounded with the sights and smells of exquisite Italian cuisine, matched only by the tastes of the food as the family sat down at a private banquet table, and the sounds of Italy, played by island musician Kiana Luna on her acoustic guitar. Wish teen Adrian, his mother, brother and grandmother were astonished by the little Italy experience in the middle of the island paradise.

"Every day since Adrian's trip was changed, we've experienced good omens that everything is as it should be—that we were meant to be here for this experience," said Jannette, Adrian's mother. "We were not expecting this at all. It's so amazing! I just can't believe it."
